


Fig. 1—Schematic diagram of a general communication system.








Net neutrality debate: Far from over

FCC Chairman Tom Wheeler's much-anticipated net neutrality rules are barreling toward a final vote later this month — but they're almost guaranteed to become immediately mired in legal challenges.

Telecom giants are deeply uneasy about Wheeler's plan to regulate broadband like a utility, and they're widely expected to drag the chairman to court. That could ensnare the FCC in a bruising, multiyear fight that outlasts not only Wheeler but the man who pushed him to take a stronger approach, President Barack Obama.

It's a familiar pattern: The agency's previous efforts to enforce net neutrality have sparked lengthy legal battles, as the FCC and federal judges have struggled to apply pre-Internet era statutes to one of the most contentious issues of the digital era.


Supporters argue the policy landscape has shifted dramatically in favor of tough regulation, and they're confident they'll persevere. But agency veterans know all too well the issue is destined to head to court — and could eventually land back in the lap of an FCC that looks very different than it does today.

Telecom giants "know there's one place in the world where no one is watching YouTube, there's only one group where ideology prevails and the actual Internet experience is irrelevant," said Reed Hundt, a former Democratic FCC chairman during the Clinton administration. "And that's the [federal] judges on the D.C. circuit."

WASHINGTON — Few presidential candidates enjoyed better news coverage than <u>Barack Obama</u> in 2008. He promised unprecedented "openness in government" and a new era of transparency.


